


















Swap Meet Fun

Zippo Fuel Can Exhibit

A unique exhibit of 47 vintage Zippo fluid cans will be on display in the Zippo customer service tent, courtesy of Fuel Plant Manager, Ralph Pearce. The collection spans from the early 30's to present, and features an original yellow, black and red tin can and a unique glass bottle used during WWII. While you're there, fill up your lighter with Zippo lighter fluid using an antique fuel pump, or replace your worn out flint.
